

RANGE RULES

1. You **MUST** obey all commands from the Range Safety Officer (RSO) immediately.
2. All shooters must sign-in with the RSO, show ID or pay range fees before bringing firearms and equipment to the firing line.
3. A parent or responsible adult must accompany any shooter under the age of 18.
4. All firearms must be unloaded when entering or leaving the range. Loaded pistols properly holstered are allowed.
5. Uncased firearms must be carried with muzzle UP when entering or leaving the firing line, or to and from the parking lot.
6. Uncase or case firearms at the shooting benches with muzzles pointed down range at all time.
7. Eye and ear protection are **REQUIRED** for everyone while on the firing line. Prescription eyewear or sunglasses are acceptable substitutes for safety glasses.
8. A live fire time period will normally be 15 minutes. A cease-fire will then be called for target set-up, replacement or retrieval.
9. When a cease-fire is called, all firearms must be cleared by; unloading, locking all actions / bolts open, removing magazines, inserting an Empty Chamber Indicator (ECI) and grounding firearms on the bench. Then stand behind the yellow safety line and wait for the RSO command to move forward.
10. Do not stop at or handle anything on the shooting benches during a cease-fire.
11. It is your responsibility to inspect the target frame for damage prior to use. The RSO will inspect the frame after use, before returning it to storage. A fee will be charged for any damage caused by a shooter to target frames.
12. The general public must use paper targets. Any exceptions must be approved by the RSO.
13. Shotguns may be fired, but only on your targets and frames, after getting approval from the RSO.
14. All shooters will pickup their brass and trash and discard it in the appropriate containers behind the firing line.
15. The RSO has the right to inspect any firearm or ammunition for safety reasons.

Other prohibited activities:

No unsafe gun handling

No armor piercing, tracer, or incendiary ammo

No full automatic fire

No 50cal. BMG ammo

No drawing from holsters – unless authorized by the RSO

No smoking on the firing line

No alcohol or drug use anywhere on the range.

Violation of any Range Rules may result in expulsion from the range and possible loss of Club membership.
